# FORMAT OF NATIONAL AND LOCAL LITTLE BRITCHES RODEO

We follow the formatting, and all rules from the National Little Britches Rodeo Association. Rule for the National Little Britches Association can be found on the National website as well as on our local website. Any rules not covered in the National rule book can be found in our Ground Rules listed below as well as on our website.

It's important to understand the two associations (National association and our Local association). These two associations give contestants opportunities both at the local level here in the North Georgia area, and at the National level in Guthrie, Ok. You can be successful at BOTH at the same time. That's the beauty of being a part of Little Britches.

**Let's compare the two different Little Britches memberships.**  
 North Georgia Little Britches is a franchise of the National Little Britches Rodeo Assoc.

**Should you become a National Member, a Local Member, or both?**  
 Competing at our rodeos provide points toward National Little Britches AND our Local Little Britches.

*It is highly recommended you become a member in both associations as the savings in only joining one is very minimal, whereas the opportunities in joining both are abundant.*

# ENTERING RODEOS

## NATIONAL AND LOCAL MEMBERSHIPS

Here are very helpful step by step directions to enter both at the National level and/or our Local (North Georgia) level at our rodeos.

It's VERY important to pay close attention to the entry deadlines for each rodeo. Those dates are set by the National office and we do not have control of them.

### HOW TO REGISTER AND ENTER NORTH GEORGIA LITTLE BRITCHES RODEOS

<p><b>1</b></p> <p><b>APPLY FOR YOUR MEMBERSHIP</b></p> <p>Visit the National Little Britches website to complete your membership application and pay the membership fee.</p> <p>Processing takes 2-5 days to complete before you are able to enter any rodeos.</p> <p><b>Remember to give your membership enough time to be processed before the entry deadline!</b></p>	<p><b>2</b></p> <p><b>ENTER YOUR CHILD IN AN UPCOMING RODEO</b></p> <p>Once your membership is approved and no longer shows as 'pending' on the National Little Britches website, you can enter rodeos online, on the national website.</p> <p>Remember, we host two separate rodeos each weekend, so if you're competing in both, you'll need to enter each one individually.</p> <p>For non-sanctioned events, call the rodeo secretary at 423-421-3837 before the entry deadline.</p> <p><b>Entries close 11 days before each rodeo. Late entries are accepted with a fee.</b></p>	<p><b>3</b></p> <p><b>GET TO KNOW: LOCAL &amp; NATIONAL RULES</b></p> <p>You'll get your National Little Britches back number and rule book by mail. This back number is valid for the entire season at both national and local rodeos.</p> <p><b>If you lose it, a replacement fee applies.</b></p> <p>Be sure to review both National Little Britches rules and North Georgia ground rules, as they may differ from other associations.</p> <p>North Georgia LB rules are on our website, and National LB rules are on the National LB website.</p> <p><b>Both sets of rules are enforced at all rodeos.</b></p>	<p><b>4</b></p> <p><b>NEW THIS YEAR: PAYING LOCAL FEES</b></p> <p><b>NEW THIS YEAR!</b></p> <p>You'll receive an email from North Georgia Little Britches with an invoice for your North Georgia membership and entry fees, as well as National fees.</p> <p>(You'll have already paid your National membership fee during registration.)</p> <p>Click the link in the email to pay your fees prior to the Friday before the rodeo.</p> <p>Fee details can be found on the North Georgia Little Britches website.</p>	<p><b>5</b></p> <p><b>LOCAL MEMBERSHIP PACKET</b></p> <p>You must complete the North Georgia Little Britches Membership Packet from our website and bring it to the registration table between 8-10am the day of the first rodeo.</p> <p>Please note that some documents require a notary, and <b>we can't guarantee a notary will be available on site.</b></p>

On the morning of your first rodeo, please visit the Registration Table between **8:00 AM and 10:00 AM** to submit your paperwork from the Membership packet and confirm that all fees are paid.

**Note: There will be no one at the Registration Table outside of these hours, so make sure to check in during this window.**

You **MUST** check in at the registration table even though you paid online.

Every contestant **MUST** check in at the Registration Table before entering the arena to compete. No exceptions!

# 2024-2025 SCHEDULE & LOCATIONS

This season we were blessed to be able to not only hold rodeos at the covered Crazy P arena in Cedartown Georgia, but to also add an additional location in Franklin Georgia at the Heard Co covered arena. This helps us expand our memberships across the Northern parts of Georgia and allows everyone to take turns at traveling the distances.

Crazy P arena does not offer hook ups or stall rentals however generators and small lot panels are allowed without a fee.

Heard County Arena offers hook ups and stall rentals, and you can bring your own generator and small lot panels without a fee. Stay tuned to our Facebook page for details on the hook ups and stalls. Concessions are typically offered at both locations and often times we have food truck as well (but neither are guaranteed).

Our local rodeo season runs from the fall until late spring every year, with our year end awards ceremony scheduled after our last rodeo. Our rodeo schedule including dates, and locations can be found on our website. Our season is complete once we send off our National qualifiers to compete in Oklahoma in July representing the state of Georgia.

Our standard schedule is to hold two rodeos per weekend. One rodeo on Saturday, and one rodeo on Sunday. However, due to the high cost of producing a rodeo, and in trying to keep fees down for our members our board made the decision that if the number of contestants entered is less than 60 for both rodeos then both of those rodeos will be run back-to-back on Saturday with no rodeo on Sunday. Attention Trail Course and Rough Stock Riders – your events for both rodeos will always be on Saturday (back-to-back for both rodeos). Rough stock & Trail will never compete on Sunday.

The decision for both rodeos spread out over two days, or ran back-to-back on Saturday will be made within 24 hours from the close of entries, and an announcement on Facebook will be made. This decision is entirely up to the local board of directors.

# GUIDELINES AND GROUND RULE FOR NORTH GEORGIA LITTLE BRITCHES RODEO ASSOC.

**\*\*\* Please note: All National Little Britches rules apply at our local rodeos at all times. These local ground rules are in addition to but never override National rules. \*\*\***

## ENTRIES

ENTRIES FOR ALL SANCTIONED EVENTS MUST BE DONE ON THE NATIONAL LITTLE BRITCHES WEBSITE. ALL NON-SANCTIONED EVENT ENTRIES NEED TO BE CALLED IN DIRECTLY TO OUR LOCAL SECRETARY. THE ENTRY DEADLINE FOR BOTH SANCTIONED AND NON-SANCTIONED EVENTS IS MIDNIGHT 11 DAYS PRIOR TO THE RODEO (WHICH FALLS ON TUESDAY THE WEEK PRIOR TO THE RODEO)

**\*\*REMINDER FOR NEW MEMBERS\*\* YOU NEED TO ALLOW YOUR NEWLY PURCHASED NATIONAL MEMBERSHIP 5-7 DAYS TO PROCESS BEFORE YOU HAVE ACCESS TO ENTER ANY RODEO ONLINE.**

## LATE CALL INS

LATE ENTRIES MUST BE CALLED IN DIRECTLY TO OUR LOCAL RODEO SECRETARY. LATE ENTRIES ARE ONLY ACCEPTED FOR 24 HOURS AFTER THE ENTRY DEADLINE ON THE NATIONAL WEBSITE HAS EXPIRED. THERE WILL BE A \$30.00 LATE ENTRY FEE FOR ALL MEMBERS, AND NON-MEMBERS. NO EXCEPTIONS. IF YOU ARE HAVING TROUBLE ENTERING ON THE NATIONAL WEBSITE PLEASE CALL THE NATIONAL OFFICE DIRECTLY.

## TURN OUTS / REFUND OF ENTRY FEES

IF A CONTESTANT TURNS OUT WITHOUT A VET RELEASE, DOCTOR'S RELEASE OR SCHOOL RELEASE THEY WILL AUTOMATICALLY LOSE THEIR ENTRANCE FEES. A RELEASE FOR A SCHOOL EVENT MUST BE A WRITTEN NOTIFICATION FROM A SCHOOL OFFICIAL. OUR LOCAL SECRETARY MUST BE NOTIFIED OF ANY RELEASES PRIOR TO THE RODEO STOCK DRAWS IN ORDER TO HAVE STOCK OR EVENT FEES REFUNDED. IF A VISIBLE INJURY TO A CONTESTANT OR A CONTESTANT'S ANIMAL OCCURS DURING THE RODEO, THE INJURY NEEDS TO BE VERIFIED BY A RODEO DIRECTOR TO HAVE FEES REFUNDED.

## ROPING EVENTS

- IN THE SENIOR TIE DOWN ROPING, SENIOR BREAKAWAY ROPING, SENIOR RIBBON ROPING, AND JUNIOR BREAKAWAY ROPING CONTESTANTS WILL BE ALLOWED 1 LOOP FOR EACH RUN.
- IN THE SENIOR TEAM ROPING, AND THE JUNIOR RIBBON ROPING CONTESTANTS WILL BE ALLOWED 2 LOOPS FOR EACH RUN.
- IN THE JUNIOR TEAM ROPING CONTESTANTS WILL BE ALLOWED 3 LOOPS BETWEEN THE TEAM FOR EACH RUN.
- IN ALL RIBBON ROPING EVENTS ONCE, THE RUNNER PULLS THE RIBBON FROM THE CALF, THE ROPER MUST IMMEDIATELY UN-DALLY AND RELEASE PRESSURE FROM THE CALF.

## BARRELS/POLES

- THE AREA WILL BE DRUG EVERY 10
- YOU ARE PERMITTED TO CIRCLE YOUR HORSE AFTER YOUR RUN IN THE ARENA BEFORE PROCEEDING TO THE ALLEY

## ARENA

- THE "HAT LINE" IS SET AT THE ENTRANCE TO THE ALLEY FOR ALL OF OUR RODEOS. IF YOU ARE UNSURE WHERE EXACTLY THAT LINE IS PLEASE ASK THE EVENT, OR ARENA DIRECTOR PRIOR TO YOUR RUN.
- HELPERS MAY ASSIST WITH A CONTESTANT'S HORSES INTO THE ALLEY, BUT MAY NOT CROSS INTO THE ARENA. ANY HELPER CROSSING INTO THE ARENA WILL RESULT IN THE CONTESTANT BEING GIVEN NO TIME. (HELPERS ARE OF COURSE ALLOWED TO GO INTO THE ARENA WITH YOUNG OR EXPERIENCED RIDERS WITH THE UNDERSTANDING THAT THEIR TIME WILL NOT BE COUNTED TOWARDS POINTS)
- ANYONE IN THE ARENA MUST BE IN WESTERN ATTIRE!

## RODEO GROUNDS

- THERE SHOULD BE ABSOLUTELY NO RIDING DOUBLE OR BARE-BACK ON THE GROUNDS. THIS IS A NATIONAL RULE THAT MUST BE FOLLOWED.
- ALL JUDGES CALLS ARE FINAL! IF A CONTESTANT WISHED TO APPEAL A CALL, THEY MUST SEE THE ARENA DIRECTOR AND FILE AN APPEAL.
- CONTESTANT MUST BE IN FULL RODEO ATTIRE WITH THEIR BACK NUMBER ON DURING THE RODEO (YES-EVEN IF THEIR EVENT IS OVER).

## RE-RUNS/ RE-RIDES AND APPEALS

- SEE NATIONAL RULE BOOK PAGE 66 REGARDING RE-RIDES/ RE-RUNS
- CONTESTANT MUST DECLARE THEMSELVES IF THEY FEEL THEY HAVE BEEN FOULED. ANY ATTEMPT TO COMPETE AFTER THE FOUL WILL NEGATE ANY CLAIM FOR A RE-RUN.
- CONTESTANTS/ PARENTS OR HELPERS SHALL NOT TRY TO INFLUENCE JUDGES.
- ALL JUDGES CALLS ARE FINAL! IF A CONTESTANT WISHES TO APPEAL A CALL, THEY MUST SEE THE ARENA DIRECTOR AND FILE AN APPEAL.
- IF CONTESTANT WISHES TO APPEAL THE JUDGE'S CALL THAT PROCESS IS DETAILED IN THE NATIONAL RULE BOOK ON PAGE 41. SEE THE ARENA DIRECTOR TO INITIATE AN APPEAL.

## NON-SANCTIONED EVENTS

- NON-SANCTIONED EVENTS ARE EVENTS THAT ARE OFFERED AT OUR LOCAL NORTH GEORGIA LITTLE BRITCHES RODEOS IN AGE DIVISIONS THAT ARE NOT OFFERED AT THE NATIONAL LEVEL. (EXAMPLE: CHUTE DOGGING IS NOT OFFERED IN THE SENIOR DIVISION BY NATIONAL LITTLE BRITCHES, BUT OUR LOCAL RODEOS DO OFFER IT IN THE SENIOR BOYS AND SENIOR GIRLS DIVISIONS)
- NATIONAL RULES APPLY TO ALL EVENTS REGARDLESS IF THEY ARE SANCTIONED FOR THAT AGE DIVISION OR NOT.
- TO ENTER A NON-SANCTIONED EVENT, YOU MUST CALL YOUR ENTRY DIRECTLY INTO THE LOCAL RODEO SECRETARY (CONTACT INFO ON OUR WEBSITE) BY THE SAME DEADLINE POSTED FOR ALL REGULAR SANCTIONED EVENTS.
- POINTS EARNED FROM ANY NON-SANCTIONED EVENTS ARE NOT REPORTED TO THE NATIONAL OFFICE, AND DO NOT COUNT TOWARDS NATIONAL POINTS SINCE THEY DO NOT OFFER THOSE EVENTS.
- THERE MUST BE A MINIMUM OF 5 ENTRIES IN ANY NON-SANCTIONED EVENT IN ORDER FOR THAT EVENT TO BE HELD
- POINTS FROM NON-SANCTIONED EVENTS WILL NOT COUNT TOWARD LOCAL "ALL AROUND" POINTS

## POINTS

- NATIONAL LITTLE BRITCHES POINTS CAN BE VIEWED ON THE NATIONAL LITTLE BRITCHES WEBSITE BY CLICKING ON "POINTS & STANDING" AND THEN CLICK ON "RIDER SNAPSHOT"
- LOCAL NORTH GEORGIA POINTS WILL BE POSTED ON THE WEBSITE BY WITHIN ONE WEEK AFTER THE RODEOS.
- FOR A BREAKDOWN OF HOW POINTS ARE ISSUED PLEASE SEE THE NATIONAL LITTLE BRITCHES RULE BOOK
- POINTS EARNED AT NATIONALS &/OR LOCAL LITTLE BRITCHES RODEOS PRIOR TO JOINING EITHER WILL NOT BE RETROACTIVE. POINTS ONLY BEGIN TO ACCUMULATE ONCE A MEMBERSHIP IS OBTAINED.
- POINTS EARNED FROM ANY NON-SANCTIONED EVENTS ARE NOT REPORTED TO THE NATIONAL OFFICE, AND DO NOT COUNT TOWARDS NATIONAL POINTS SINCE THEY DO NOT OFFER THOSE EVENTS.

## POINT SYSTEM (FOR BOTH NATIONAL & LOCAL LITTLE BRITCHES)

ALL DIVISIONS  
ALL EVENTS: 1ST- 2ND - 3RD - 4TH - 5TH - 6TH - 7TH  
POINTS 70 - 60 - 50 - 40 - 30 - 20- 10

THE GRADUATED POINTS, CALLED COMPETITOR POINTS, WILL BE BASED ON EVERY GROUP OF 5 CONTESTANTS. 1 PT/FOR EVERY 5 RUNS/RIDES COMPLETED, COMPETITOR POINTS ARE ADDED TO EACH PLACE AWARDED.

THEREFORE:

- 1-5 COMPETITORS = 1 COMPETITOR POINT
- 6-10 COMPETITORS = 2 COMPETITOR POINTS
- 11-15 COMPETITORS = 3 COMPETITOR POINTS
- 16-20 COMPETITORS = 4 COMPETITOR POINTS
- 21-25 COMPETITORS = 5 COMPETITOR POINTS
- 26-30 COMPETITORS = 6 COMPETITOR POINTS
- 31-35 COMPETITORS = 7 COMPETITOR POINTS
- 36-40 COMPETITORS = 8 COMPETITOR POINTS
- 41-45 COMPETITORS = 9 COMPETITOR POINTS
- 46-50 COMPETITORS = 10 COMPETITOR POINTS
- 51-55 COMPETITORS = 11 COMPETITOR POINTS, ETC.

COMPETITOR POINTS WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE NUMBER OF CONTESTANTS ACTUALLY COMPETING IN THAT EVENT WHEN THE EVENT SHEETS ARE TURNED INTO THE RODEO SECRETARY FOR THAT RODEO.

## REQUIREMENTS TO QUALIFY FOR NATIONAL LITTLE BRITCHES FINALS IN GUTHRIE, OK

- PLACE IN THE TOP SIX IN SAID EVENT SIX TIMES AT ANY NATIONAL LITTLE BRITCHES RODEO IN THE U.S. (SEE NATIONAL LITTLE BRITCHES RULE BOOK FOR FURTHER INFORMATION)
- IT'S IMPORTANT TO KNOW THAT MOST RESERVATIONS AND SUCH FOR NATIONAL FINALS START AFTER THE FIRST OF THE YEAR AND STALLS, CAMPING SPOTS, ETC. BOOK UP QUICKLY!!! ## REQUIREMENTS FOR NORTH GEORGIA LITTLE BRITCHES YEAR END AWARDS

- PAID MEMBERSHIP FOR NORTH GEORGIA LITTLE BRITCHES
- ATTEND OR WATCH VIDEO (ON OUR WEBSITE) OUR MANDATORY MEETING AT THE FIRST RODEO OF THE SEASON
- COMPLETED MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION SIGNED AND NOTARIZED
- ARENA RELEASE SIGNED
- ACKNOWLEDGEMENT FROM SIGNED
- ALL FUNDRAISING REQUIREMENTS (LISTED BELOW) MET BY THE DEADLINE. IN ORDER TO BE FAIR TO EVERYONE THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS!
- EACH CONTESTANT MUST COMPETE IN ONE MORE THAN HALF OF THE RODEOS OFFERED FOR THE ENTIRE SEASON. (IN EACH EVENT THEY WISH TO QUALIFY FOR AWARDS IN).
- TO QUALIFY FOR ALL AROUND AWARDS EACH CONTESTANT MUST COMPETE IN AT LEAST TWO OR MORE EVENTS IN ONE MORE THAN HALF THE RODEOS OFFERED THE ENTIRE SEASON.
  - POINTS FROM NON-SANCTIONED EVENTS WILL NOT COUNT TOWARD LOCAL "ALL AROUND" POINTS
  - POINTS FROM ADDITIONAL SANCTIONED EVENTS WILL COUNT TOWARDS LOCAL "ALL AROUND" POINTS EVEN IF THE REQUIRED NUMBER OF RODEOS IS NOT MET FOR THOSE EVENTS

## VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS FOR NORTH GEORGIA LITTLE BRITCHES MEMBERS

ALL MEMBERS ARE REQUIRED TO VOLUNTEER FOR A TOTAL OF FOUR SLOTS DURING THE RODEO SEASON. TWO SLOTS MUST BE COMPLETED BY THE LAST RODEO IN DECEMBER. THE TWO REMAINING SLOTS MUST BE COMPLETED BETWEEN THE JANUARY RODEOS AND BEFORE THE LAST RODEO OF THE SEASON. A VOLUNTEER SLOT WILL BE TO WORK FOR AN ENTIRE EVENT (ALL AGE DIVISIONS).

THESE VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS MUST BE MET IN ORDER FOR A CONTESTANT TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR YEAR-END AWARDS. PLEASE UNDERSTAND THERE WILL NOT BE ANY EXCEPTIONS!

YOU MAY OPT TO "BUY OUT" OF VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS FOR A COST OF \$125 PER SLOT.

BELOW ARE THE STEPS THAT MUST BE FOLLOWED IN ORDER FOR YOUR VOLUNTEER SLOTS TO COUNT AND BE RECORDED;

### ***(DO NOT SKIP ANY OF THESE STEPS)***

- #1 WORK CARDS WILL BE GIVEN TO EACH CONTESTANT AT THE FIRST RODEO (ONE PER FAMILY). IT IS MEMBERS RESPONSIBILITY TO KEEP UP WITH THE CARDS. REPLACEMENTS CAN BE OBTAINED FROM THE RODEO SECRETARY BUT NO SIGNATURES WILL BE REPLACED ON LOST CARDS.
- #2 SIGN UP FOR A VOLUNTEER SLOT ON THE ON-LINE SIGN-UP GENIUS. THESE SIGN-UPS ARE POSTED ON OUR FACEBOOK PAGE PRIOR TO EACH RODEO WEEKEND.
- #3 WHEN YOUR SLOT TIME COMES FIND THE EVENT DIRECTOR TO GET INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR EVENT.
- #4 UPON COMPLETING YOUR VOLUNTEER SLOT PLEASE HAVE YOUR VOLUNTEER CARD SIGNED OFF ON BY THE EVENT DIRECTOR, OR WHOEVER YOU REPORTED TO FOR YOUR VOLUNTEER SLOT.
- #5 AFTER COMPLETING TWO SLOTS RETURN YOUR SIGNED VOLUNTEER CARD TO THE RODEO SECRETARY (UP IN THE ANNOUNCER BOOTH). YOUR VOLUNTEER CARD WILL BE KEPT AND RECORDED BY OUR STAFF. (YOU ARE WELCOME TO TAKE A PICTURE OF YOUR SIGNED CARD BEFORE TURNING IT IN)

IT IS VERY IMPORTANT THAT YOU COMPLETE ALL FOUR OF THESE STEPS TO INSURE YOU RECEIVE CREDIT!!
